

Workcamp 2010

What: A chance to live in a Christian community for a week while serving those less fortunate by providing house renovations that make the house warmer, safer or dryer.

When: July 24-30, 2010

- Leave Precious Blood for Workcamp Saturday afternoon
- Return to Precious Blood Friday afternoon
- You must be there for the ENTIRE program. You can not come late or leave early.

Where: Woodbridge, Virginia

John Paul the Great High School will be homebase.

Sleeping quarters are separated with girls/women on one wing or building, boys/men in another.

Responsibilities of Workcampers

- Complete and return paperwork and fees on a timely basis
- Participate in planning and training meetings
- Assist in fundraising
- Help recruit adults to go with us
- Obtain tools to take to Workcamp
- During Workcamp, have a “can do” attitude

Selection of Participants

- Must be an active member of the parish (Mass, CCD, etc.)
- Must have completed freshman year (9th grade) by June 2009
- Must demonstrate a maturity level that is needed for the program
- Must have good attendance at meetings

Cost and Payment

- \$450 is needed for each participant (teen and adult), but most of this will be raised through fundraising. This pays for building materials, food, and evening programs.
- Families can expect to pay a portion of this at the time of application (February). There will be a registration fee of \$150 per camper. If fundraising is successful, we can return a portion or all of the down payment. If the registration fee would keep you from attending camp, please talk to Mrs. Bennett or myself.
- Campers will need minimal pocket money. Occasionally, performers will have CDs for sale, or a crew may stop at 7-11 for a snack.
